Please follow these instructions *carefully*. Only COMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED.

Applications are due in the AHS Counseling Center by Noon on March 31, 2017

Please submit all of the following REQUIRED documents (#s 1-5 below) **with your application:**

- 1. **Résumé** that includes:
 - School Activities
 - Awards
 - Community Involvement
 - Volunteer Activities
 - Employment History
- 2. A copy of your **transcript(s)**, including 2016-2018 1st semester/quarter grades. Transcripts must be stamped by the registrar, but should NOT be sealed. *Please do not submit transcripts in an envelope.*
- 3. Page 1 (**only**) of the 2017-2018 **Student Aid Report (SAR)** from FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) to document your EFC. *Note:* The SAR is the report that you should see when you log into your FAFSA account and click on "View Processed Information (**PDF Version**)". You will see a box with Application Date, Process Date, EFC, DRN, etc. near the top of the report. The committee only needs page 1 of the report, which is most easily viewable/printed on the PDF version.
- 4. *We'd like to know more about you.* In an **essay or personal statement** tell us about yourself, your educational goals, career objectives and what you see for yourself in the future.
- 5. Completed Application form clipped to the front of the application packet.

Optional Information:

- OFFICIAL **SAT and/or ACT score reports**
- Recommendations:** You may include up to two (2) recommendations from a teacher, coach, employer, club advisor, pastor, etc. Recommendations on letterhead are preferred.
- Supporting Information Statement:** Is there anything else we should know? You may attach a one page supporting information statement to help us to know you and your circumstances better, or to explain any omitted documents. *Note: This document is not required.* In the past, students have used this option to explain extenuating family or financial circumstances, reasons for omitted documents, etc.

Please do NOT:

- Submit your application in any type of binder or folder
- Include photos, copies of awards or materials not specifically requested in the application (no part of the application will be returned)
