**(Use the checklist to verify that required documents are included in your application)**

**REQUIRED** Information, please submit the following documents (#s 1-6 below):

- 1. **Application Pages – Applicant/Financial Information:** Complete all information required with electronic or regular signature at the bottom of page.
- 2. **Application Page – Applicant Questions:** Answer completely questions A, B, and C.
- 3. **Résumé:** List as many of the following as applicable: School Activities; Awards; Community Involvement; Volunteer Activities; Employment History.
- 4. **Transcript(s):** Include 2019-2020 first semester grades. Transcripts must be stamped by the registrar, but should NOT be sealed. *Please do not submit transcripts in an envelope.*
- 5. **Financial Information:** Provide relevant information, as selected on the attached application.
- 6. **Completed Application form:** Clip the form to the front of the application packet.

If you plan on, or are you considering, attending a **FOUR-year college or university**, please submit the following additional **REQUIRED** documents with your application:

- 7. **SAT and/or ACT** score reports.

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**OPTIONAL** Information:

- Personal Statement.** We want to get to know who you are. This could include previous work experience, how you've overcome challenges, your hopes and dreams, and anything else that makes up your unique story.
- Recommendations:** If you choose to include optional recommendations, include no more than two (2) from people who know you well and with whom you have a strong relationship with. Recommendations on letterhead are preferred.
- Supporting Information Statement:** Is there anything else we should know? You may attach a one page supporting information statement to help us to know you and your circumstances better. *Note.* In the past, students have used this option to explain extenuating family or financial circumstances, or to provide other pertinent information that didn't fit elsewhere in the application package.

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**Please do NOT:**

- Submit your application in any type of binder or folder
- Include photos, copies of awards or materials not specifically requested in the application (no part of the application will be returned)

All scholarships awarded through the Anacortes Schools Foundation are sent directly to the school chosen by the award recipient. The funds can be used for qualified education expenses as defined by the IRS for tax-free scholarships. These expenses include tuition, required fees, and course related expenses (fees, books, & supplies), but exclude room & board and travel. {See IRS Publication 970 for more detail.}
